KINDERGARTEN

1. Two fat pencils with erasers
2. One set standard 8-color fat crayons
(Please NO washable or Jumbo "So Big" crayons)
3. One set watercolors, 8 colors; Prang recommended
4. One medium size bottle of Elmer's Glue-All (not washable)
5. Scissors (pointed or blunt) metal-bladed Fiskars are preferred - No plastic blades or scissors that stick or are stiff
6. Plastic container to store crayons (Frosting container or flat sandwich container works well)
7. One package of stickers - no mini stickers or stars, please!
8. One standard box of tissues
9. One folder to keep in book bag (optional)
10. Book bag large enough to hold 9x12 papers without folding
NO pencil box (We supply storage)
11. Two Paper or Plastic Folders with clips to attach paper
12. Two glue sticks
13. Inexpensive gym shoes-to be kept at school for Phys. Ed.
Please label all items with Sharpie marker

GRADE TWO

1. Composition Note Book-Hard Cover 9¾ x 7½ 100 sheets wide-ruled
2. Pencils (12) – Please sharpen
3. Eraser
4. Colored markers (8 count)
5. Elmer's white glue (no paste, please)
6. Scissors (Fiskar recommended – pointed)
7. Crayons – Box of 24 – no more
8. One Folder – Poly pocket folder with 3 prongs
9. Paint set (Prang or Crayola – 8 colors)
10. Book bag
11. Two boxes of tissues (to be stored and used as needed)
12. Inexpensive gym shoes-to be kept at school for Phys. Ed.

GRADE FOUR

1. Blue and red ink pen
2. Pencils and erasers
3. Wide-ruled loose-leaf paper (not college ruled)
4. Seven pocket folders with clips and pockets
5. Large school box to hold supplies
6. Crayons – Box of 24 - not washable
7. Scissors (Fiskar recommended)
8. White glue (Elmer's) - no glue sticks
9. 12 inch ruler - make sure it has Metric units
10. Box of colored pencils
11. One regular size box of tissues
12. One box of watercolors (Prang is best)
13. One red grading pencil or pen
14. One package thin or thick markers
15. Sturdy book bag or backpack

GRADE ONE

1. Scissors (Fiskar recommended)
2. Eraser
3. 8 oz. bottle of white glue (no paste, please)
4. Markers - Set of 8 – Wide Tip, Crayola recommended-not permanent
5. School Box
6. Watercolors (Prang recommended or Crayola)
7. Paper punch
8. Skinny pencils (5) Yellow #2 recommended (sharpened)
9. Crayons-2 boxes of 24 is better than larger box (Crayola recommended, should be initialed for safekeeping)
10. Two folders (2 bottom pockets at least 1 of the 2 plastic)
11. Book bag
12. One box of tissues
13. One pack of stickers to be used for paper checking
14. Activity book
15. Inexpensive gym shoes-to be kept at school for Phys. Ed.
Please, put child's name on all supplies

GRADE THREE

1. At least 5 pencils with erasers (no mechanical pencils)
2. Separate erasers
3. Red checking or grading pen
4. Scissors (Fiskar recommended)
5. Elmer's glue - medium size
6. Crayons - 24 per box is fine
7. Two regular size boxes of tissues to be stored and used as needed
8. Set of markers
9. Five pocket folders with clips
10. Small supply box or pouch – no bigger than 9 by 5½
11. Book bag
12. One pack of notebook paper (wide ruled)
13. One regular size notebook (no perforated)
14. Inexpensive gym shoes-to be kept at school for Phys. Ed.
** NO LARGE BINDERS – OF ANY TYPE

GRADE FOUR (CONTINUED)

16. 2 spiral notebooks – 8½ x 11 wide rule – single subject
17. Student Planner-to be purchased at school
18. Inexpensive gym shoes-to be kept at school for Phys. Ed.
NO TRAPPERS OR LARGE BINDERS OF ANY KIND
Markers, crayons, watercolors, and pencils should include mostly primary and/or secondary colors. No Florescent Colors
